

Acton Burnell Frodesley Pitchford Ruckley & Langley Parish Council

Financial Report for the year ended 2018/2019

The Parish Council received £5413 precept monies from Shropshire Council to enable it to fulfil its statutory obligations. The Parish Council expenditure, as shown in the year end accounts, was £16380. However if the Lightsource Community Benefit receipt and transfer is put to one side, then the Council spend was £4777.

With a small amount received in interest and VAT refunds, the Council had an excess income of £747 over its expenditure for the year.

The Council again received a Community Benefit payment from Lightsource for the Solar Park within part of the parish. This money is held in a totally separate account as a Community Fund and not included in the Parish Council monies. It is used to fund community projects, such as the purchase of the defibrillators that are being installed in the four villages and the relaunch of the Village Views newsletter and production of the Directory.

The Parish Council reviewed and updated its Financial and Risk Assessment documents last July and these will be reviewed again this May.

The Council has in all aspects of its financial dealings adhered to strict guidelines ensuring that all decisions represent best value for money for the community.
