Following the difficult period some 12 mths ago when closure was a possibility, we have a more positive & brighter looking future.

With your kind award & the guaranteed write down from pitchford estate we were able to install a new sewage treatment plant & reopen the hall.

We have targetted fund raising to build up funds. With the pub night still going strong. The 200 club is fully sold & the greek night raised over £1300. currently we have some £7700 in the bank.

However planned expenditure includes

£800 Tote

£730 Insurance

£300 electric

£400 - upgrade to electric system

removing £1 metre - allowing heating to be on one £2 metre, all other energy will be included in booking fee.

Our main concern at the moment is having commissioned a structural report is that the gable ends are moving & will require remedial work which is in the region of £3500

Back to square one, we plan to have a operating fund of £2000 by Dec 17

We have welcomed 2 new committee members & support for & the importance to the hall in the community appears high at this ~~part~~ time.


Finally there is a plant sale this Saturday & a promise auction planned for September 9th.
