Village speed gateways

- The Parish Council is planning to install a total of 11 speed gateways on the approach to each of the four villages.
- The Council decided to undertake this work following concerns from residents about the speed of traffic through the villages, particularly at Frodesley crossroads
- The gateways in Frodesley will be installed in conjunction with additional speed management measures to be undertaken by Shropshire Council, including a new statutory 30 mph speed limit.
- The work should be undertaken in 2024.
- Although the main aim is to reduce the speed of vehicles travelling through the villages, the gateways will also raise the profile of the villages and make the entrance to the villages more visible.

Costs and funding

The Council has appointed JACS UK to construct and install the village gateways.

The current quoted cost for this work is £10,961.

The gateways will be funded from the Council's CIL Neighbourhood Funds monies. These are funds given to the Council by developers to help mitigate the impact of developments in the Parish, for example from increased traffic levels.

The Council currently holds £20,312.02 in CIL neighbourhood funds. In 2024 we also intend to spend money from this fund on the replacement of Frodesley Bus Shelter and repairs to Pitchford Bus Shelter.

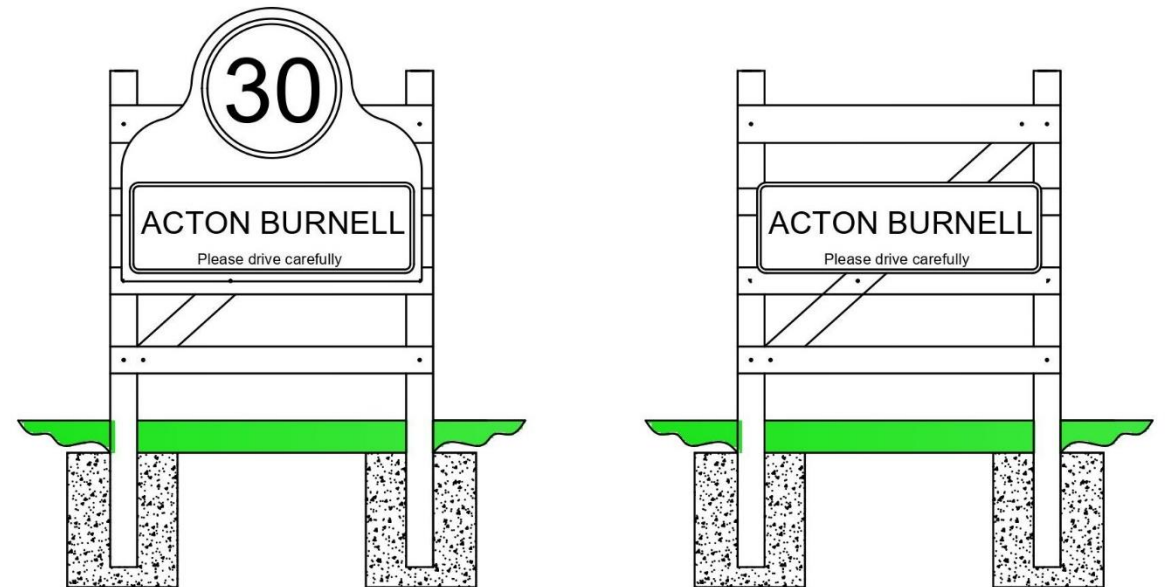
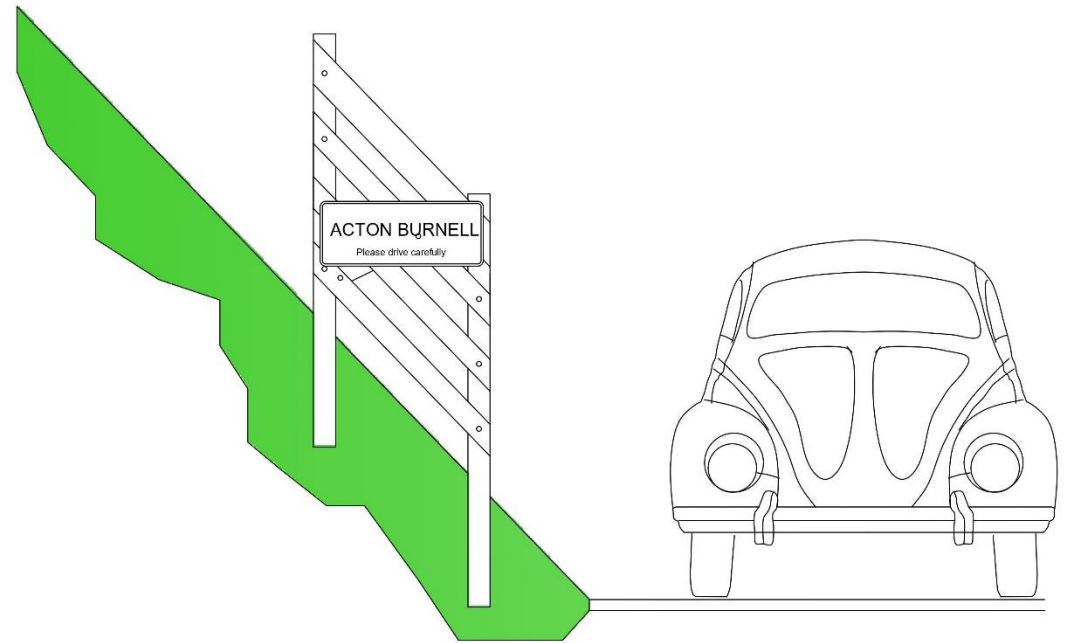
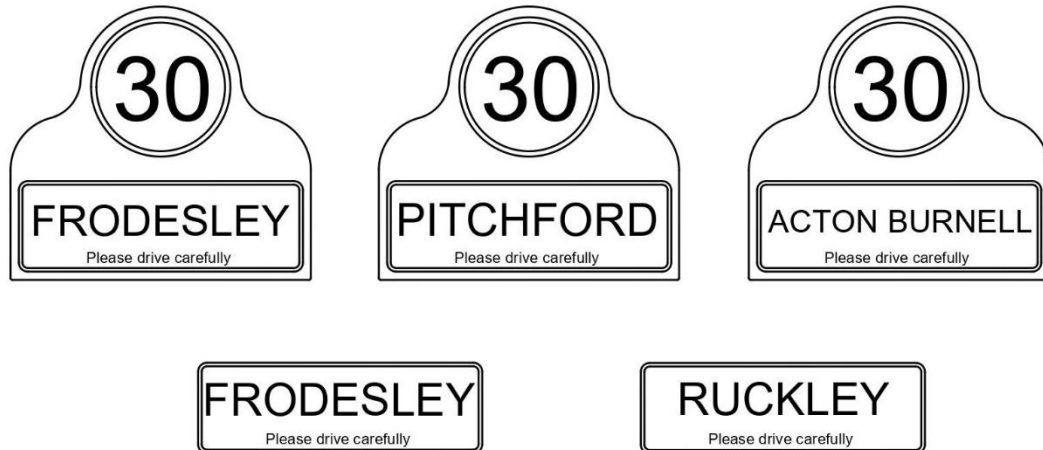


Design

The gateways will be white and made from 100% recycled plastic.

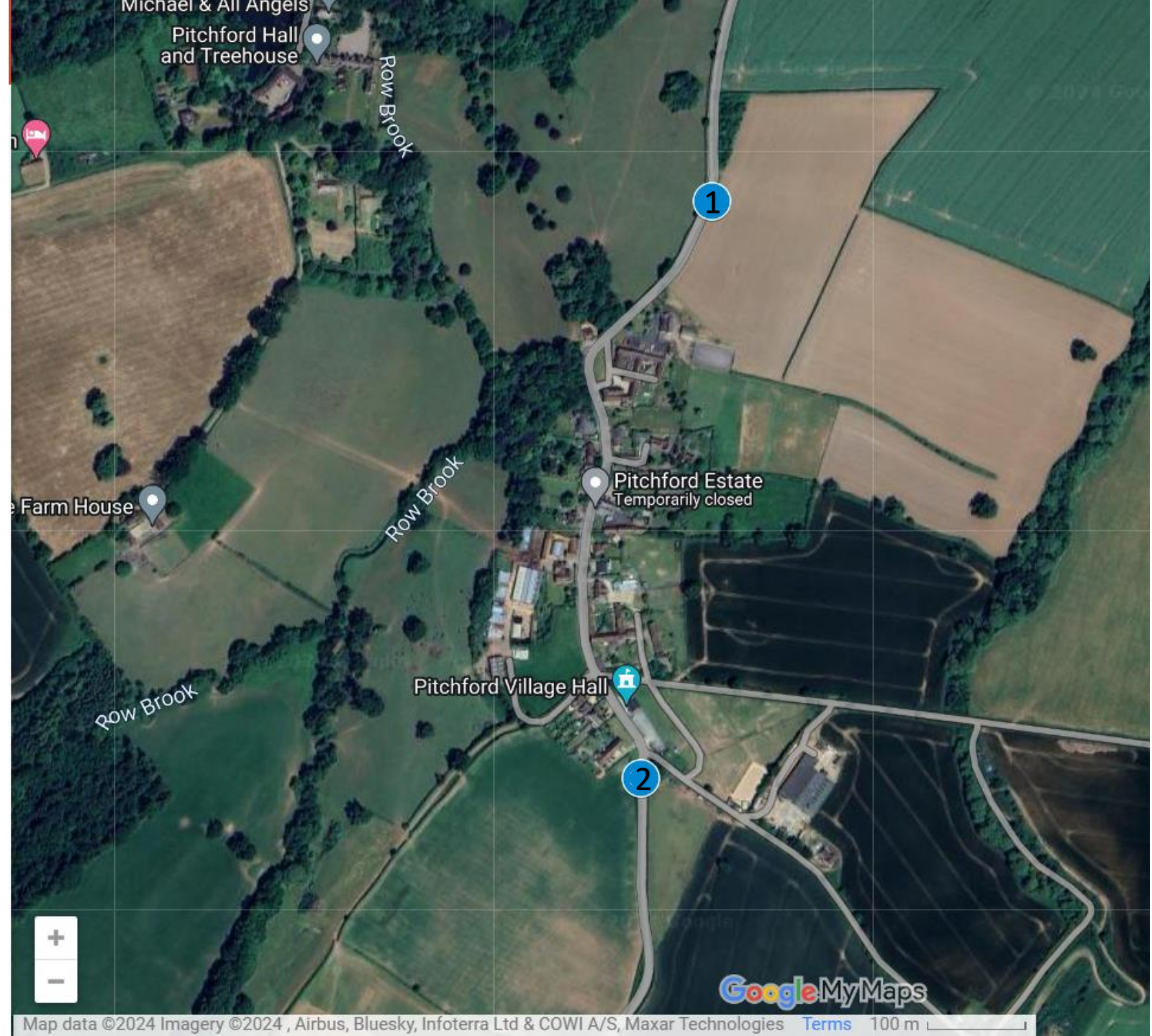
The gateways will feature the name of the village, the message “please drive carefully” and, where space allows, a 30mph roundel.

The gateways will be 1.3m high (above ground) and either 1.2m or 2m wide depending on the space available.



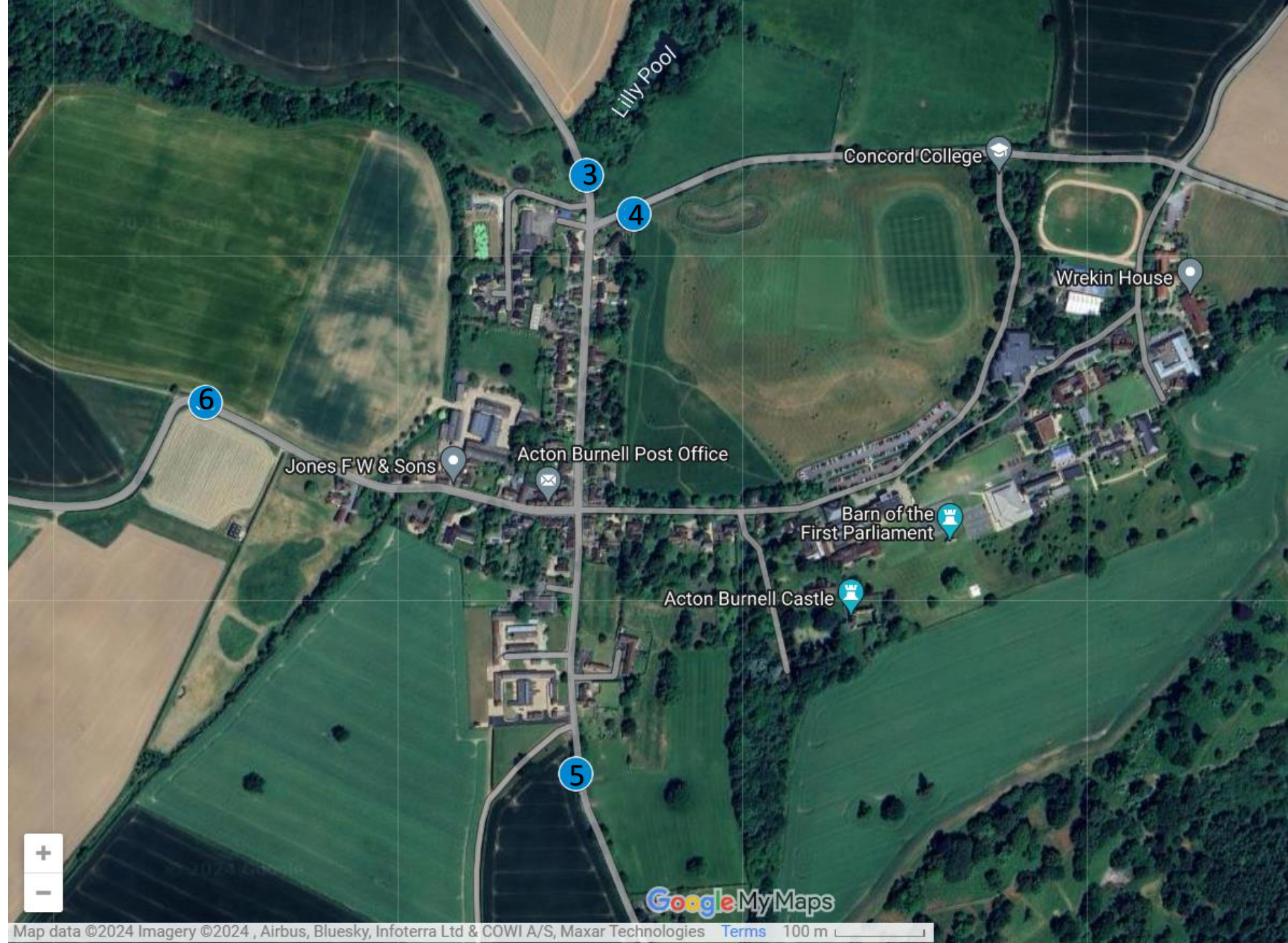
Locations: Pitchford

- Site 2 Pitchford from Acton Burnell



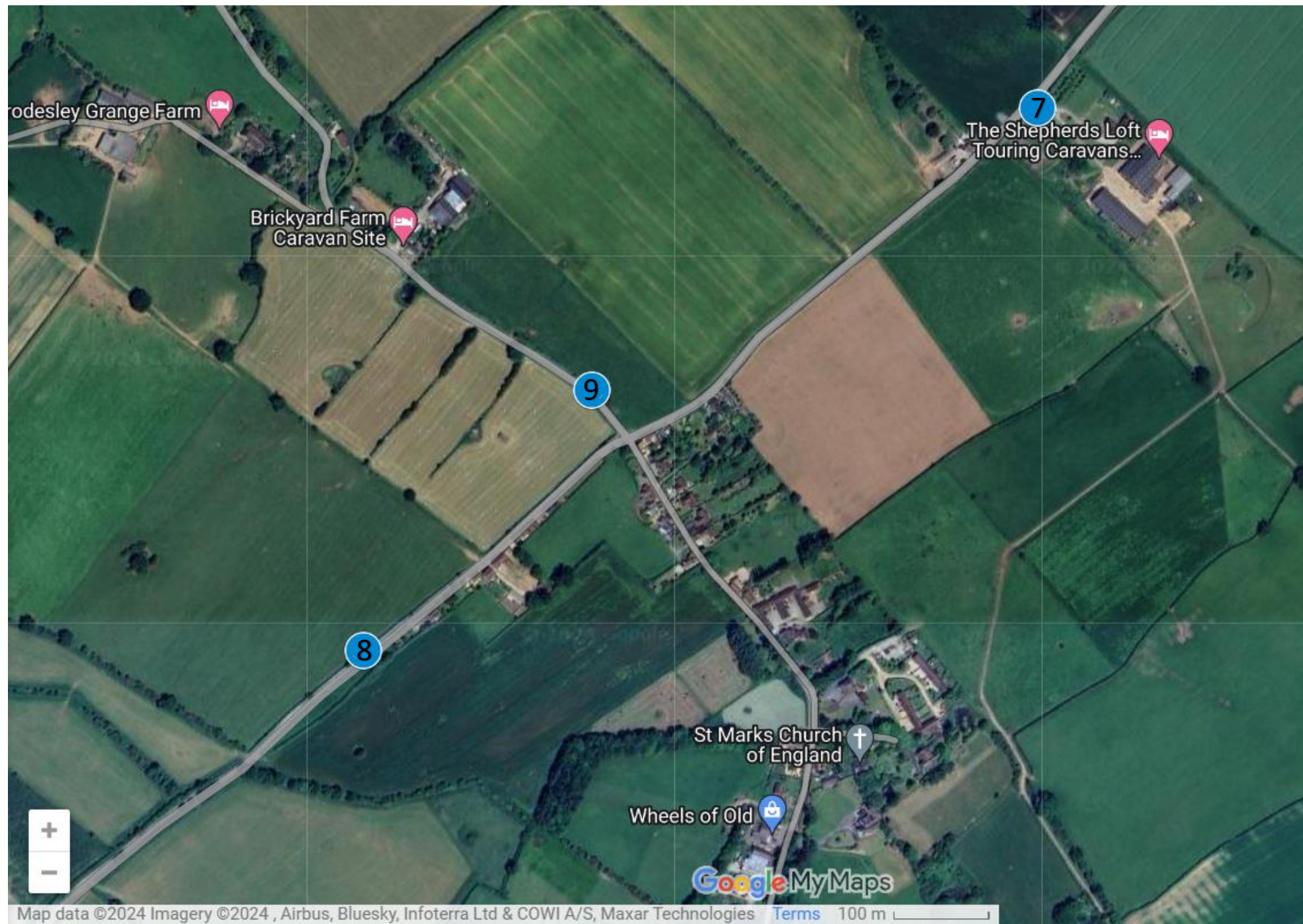
Locations: Acton Burnell
