NEWS FROM PITCHFORD VILLAGE HALL

The Village Hall in Pitchford serves all of the four parishes in our area and is home to numerous and a wide variety of events. We hope this means there will therefore something of interest to everyone in our locality.

This amenity is, however, not cheap to run and one way we try to raise funds is through the 200 CLUB. This has been in operation since around 1979 and the £2400 raised each year is split 50:50 between prizes for the lucky ones whose names are drawn from 'the hat' every month and for the electricity and the insurance bills for the Hall. Annual membership costs £12 and this is collected early in January. If you are interested in joining for 2018, then you can contact the Chairman of the Hall's Management Committee, Mike Price whose details are listed below. If you register your interest with Mike then you will get a knock on your door in early January by one of our collectors who are:

- Gilly Turner for Acton Burnell
- Judith Smith for Frodesley
- Mike Price for Pitchford, Ruckley & Langley and other outlying areas

Monthly prizes consist of a £50 first prize, with a £25 second prize, £15 third prize and a fourth prize of £10.

One of the regular events is the **PUB NIGHT** which occurs on the 3rd Friday of each month and the final two for 2017 are on **Friday 17th November** and **Friday 15th December**.

These events are usually very well attended and provide a vital service for our community in that it is the only regular meeting point for everyone in the area in addition to the local churches, so do come along and help to reduce our

drinks stock (you were particularly successful in that at the October event where the barrel ran out by 9pm meaning we will have to supply a larger one in November!!). All are welcome including kids, dogs and even adults!

The Hall can be hired for private parties or if you wish to hold an open event (such as plant sales, meal events such as October's Harvest Supper) or other meetings. Rates are extremely competitive and are designed to encourage use of the hall rather than be inhibitive. Details again can be obtained from Mike Price (Chairman) or Christine Jones (Secretary).

The Hall is in the process of some maintenance work at present (which should not affect events) including the repair of the gable ends which is being dealt with by the insurers. We also have plans to update the kitchen facilities from its current perfectly functional state to even better and there are other plans for ensuring our facility meets our future requirements.
